

2011 ROYAL RANGERS MERIT CAMP

JOB DESCRIPTION—KITCHEN/DINING HALL STAFF

Requirements

Must be at least 21 years of age.

Must be a born-again Christian, receive positive recommendation from their Pastor and be approved by the Merit Camp Staff.

Must demonstrate a willingness to cooperate with and follow the instructions of the Camp Commander.

Must agree to abide by all policies and procedures of the Merit Camp and carry out all duties contained in this job description.

All staff are asked to pay a fee as outlined on the registration form to cover part of the cost of meals and the camp for the week. This helps keep down the cost of the camp for the boys.

Must wear Royal Ranger uniform of the day while at camp.

Duties and Expectations

Take time to pray for each camper and staff member before the camp begins.

Arrive at camp by 10:00 am, complete registration process and report immediately to kitchen.

Participate in "Secret Place Devotions" each morning.

No staff are to stay in the camper's dorms other than those assigned to that dorm. No staff are to enter the camper's dorms unless they are "dorm staff" or are authorized to do so by the Camp Commander or Assistant Camp Commander.

Staff are not to take equipment from the designated equipment area without it being signed out by the Quartermaster. Staff are not to take equipment from the office area without it being signed out by the Office Coordinator. Equipment must also be signed **IN** by the Quartermaster or Office Coordinator. Report any damage to equipment at the time it is signed in.

Keep practical jokes under control. Things like water, shampoo, shaving cream, etc. in sleeping bags is not acceptable at any time. The general rule of thumb with regards to this is: Thou shalt not trespass on thy neighbor's person, property or self-esteem!

Severe discipline problems are to be referred immediately to the Camp Commander, Assistant Camp Commander or Camp Coordinator.

Be on time for the preparation of each meal as requested by Cook Canyon Head Cook. Stay after each meal until all duties have been completed. Duties are not limited to the kitchen, if asked to help with other areas do so with a willing heart.

Review Kitchen Staff Notebook in your Merit Camp Handbook; abide by all policies and procedures outlined in Handbook.

Cook Canyon Head Cook is in charge of the kitchen and Dining Hall and should be shown the respect due them.

If you have a grievance, talk to the Camp Commander. He will discuss the problem with the appropriate individuals and try to resolve the problem. Do not talk about the problem with campers or other staff members.
